

Terms and Conditions for Debit Cards and Credit Cards 2023

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1. Meaning of words used

In these Terms and Conditions, we use certain terms that have a specific meaning. We highlight these below.

<i>Debit card:</i>	a card that you can use to dispose of the account and/or to use other applications as permitted by us, among other things
<i>Spending limit:</i>	the maximum amount of which a cardholder may dispose using a card, for instance each day, week or month
<i>Unused part of the spending limit:</i>	for a debit card, the balance in the account, less any barred amounts, but plus any credit facilities on the card; for a credit card, the balance on the credit card, plus the remainder, if any, of the spending limit.
<i>Pay machine:</i>	a machine that cardholders can use to pay, using their cards
<i>Payment order:</i>	an instruction to carry out a payment issued to us by a cardholder
<i>Payment:</i>	any payment transaction ensuing from the payment services described in these terms and conditions
<i>Credit card:</i>	the card that the cardholder can use to carry out transactions up to the spending limit agreed with us
<i>Cash dispenser:</i>	a machine permitted by us that cardholders can use to withdraw money, using their cards in combination with the associated PINs
<i>Information:</i>	any and all notices, confirmations, documents, product and other terms and conditions (or amendments thereto), manuals, rules, statements (regarding the account), or commercial or other messages from us to you
<i>Credit-card statement:</i>	the statement listing the payments and retransfers effected on the credit card within a specific period
<i>Helpdesk:</i>	the helpdesk communicated by us and stated on the website
<i>Online service:</i>	Rabo Business Banking and any other online services designated and/or substituted by us
<i>Agreement:</i>	the agreement between you and us to which these terms and conditions apply
<i>PAN:</i>	the 16-digit number on your new debit or credit card. PAN stands for Primary Account Number
<i>Card:</i>	a debit card or credit card
<i>Cardholder:</i>	the party in whose name the card has been issued
<i>PIN:</i>	a secret, four-digit personal identification number belonging to your card and serving as a security code
<i>We/Rabobank:</i>	Coöperatieve Rabobank U.A., having its registered office in Amsterdam, the Netherlands
<i>Rabobank Group:</i>	the economic unity in which we are affiliated with other legal entities organizationally
<i>Rabo App:</i>	an application that you can use to access an online service
<i>Account:</i>	an account of you with us that can be accessed using a card
<i>Account holder/you:</i>	the party or parties, both collectively and individually, for whom or which we maintain the account. Thus, when we refer to 'you' or 'your,' for example in our online services, we mean the person accessing the service
<i>Applications:</i>	any and all payments, payment orders, payment transactions, cash withdrawals and any other online or other legally binding or other acts as listed on the website or agreed with us that can be carried out using a card
<i>Rules:</i>	the rules, manuals, directions, instructions, requirements and restrictions for purposes of using online services as stated on the website, of which you and/or the cardholder has/have been notified through messages in online services, or of which you have otherwise been made aware
<i>Website:</i>	www.rabobank.nl or any substitute website. This also includes subpages and links

2. *General provisions applicable to the use of the card*

1. **General provision**

- 1.1 The card is a strictly personal card of the cardholder. We will determine what data will be put on the card. The card will remain our property and may not be changed or copied in whole or in part in any way whatsoever.
- 1.2 Promptly upon receipt of the card, the cardholder must place his/her signature on it, if the rules prescribe this.
- 1.3 We will provide the cardholder with a PIN to be able to use the card. You may change the PIN belonging to credit cards and some debit cards, at a suitable cash dispenser. You can find out whether the PIN of the debit card can be changed from the letter enclosed with that debit card or from our website. We will let you and/or the cardholder know, for example through the website, what cash dispensers will be suitable for this purpose.
- 1.4 Upon receipt of the card, the cardholder must activate the card. We will determine whether a card is yet to be activated and, if so, how. The manner in which the card must be activated is described in the rules.
- 1.5 The card will be valid for a limited period. The card will no longer be valid after the last day of the month stated on the card. We may at all times change the validity of the card. We may also at all times issue a new card to the cardholder.

2. **Rules**

- 2.1 The cardholder will exclusively use the card and the associated PIN for the applications permitted by us. We may at all times autonomously restrict, change, expand or end the use of the card and the PIN for one or more applications. We will so notify you and/or the cardholder, for example through the website.
- 2.2 We may (temporarily) set additional rules with respect to the use of the card, such as setting limits, for instance minimum and maximum amounts per payment or a total amount per time unit.
- 2.3 We may at all times change the rules with immediate effect. We will notify you and/or the cardholder of the relevant changes for the card, for example through the website or a message in an online service. The cardholder and/or you will be obliged to comply with the rules.
- 2.4 You must ensure that the cardholder will at all times be aware of any and all current and amended terms and conditions and rules applicable to the use of the card. You will ensure that every cardholder knows and observes these terms and conditions.

3. **You verify the information we provide you with**

- 3.1 If we send you the information by mail, you must verify this information as soon as possible, in any case within two weeks of receipt. For example, a paper transaction statement.
- 3.2 If we provide you this information in another manner, such as through an online service, you must verify this information as soon as possible, in any case within two weeks of us providing that information.
- 3.3 You must notify us as soon as possible if you do not receive information from us that you expect or should expect to be forthcoming from us.
- 3.4 If you think something is wrong, take all reasonable measures to prevent further problems.
- 3.5 Check our information even if you make use of another payment service provider. Our information takes precedence in the event of differences.

3. Our arrangements regarding the applications and use of the card

4. Various types of cards with various options

- 4.1 We offer various types of cards. However, not every card has the same features.
- 4.2 We will be launching new debit cards soon. These new debit cards are identifiable by the PAN on the card. You or the cardholder will receive a new debit card once the expiration date of the old card has been reached or when the debit card has to be replaced for another reason. We offer two brands of new debit cards: Mastercard and Visa. We decide whether you or the cardholder receive a new Mastercard or Visa debit card.

5. New ways to pay with your card

- 5.1 There are various ways you can pay with a card. There are an increasing number of different ways to pay with a card in addition to the traditional payment methods at a pay machine in a store, e.g. at an online store. It is up to you or the cardholder whether you want to use these new payment methods.
- 5.2 Generally, you and the cardholder must have access to Rabo Business Banking to be able to use the new features. A new debit card is required for some of the new payment methods.

6. Debiting of account upon use of card

- 6.1 We will debit any amounts withdrawn or paid using the card from the account. You must ensure that the balance or the unused portion of the credit facility in the account will suffice.
- 6.2 For amounts in a currency other than the euro, we will debit the counter value of such amounts from the account in euros. We will determine the counter value in the way set forth in the Article titled "Currency".
- 6.3 The amount of a payment or withdrawal made using a debit card or digital card in euros or the counter value in euros of the amount in another currency will not always be debited from the account immediately.

7. Use of card for payment transactions and other applications

- 7.1 The cardholder may use a card to dispose of the account. In some cases, the cardholder may also use the card for other applications, for example as a means to log access to secured bicycle parking facilities. We will determine the other applications for which and the parties in respect of which you may use the card.
- 7.2 The arrangements regarding payments applicable to the account will also apply to other payment and other transactions carried out with the card. The conditions and rules applicable to the account and/or any online services will also apply, unless these terms and conditions expressly provide otherwise.
- 7.3 If the cardholder is an attorney in fact or statutory or other representative, and if the cardholder can carry out payments with the card, you will guarantee that the cardholder will not carry out the payment transactions until the cardholder has taken note of these conditions and rules, and acts upon them.
- 7.4 If the cardholder represents you, you will be obliged to fully, correctly and continuously inform the cardholder about the currently applicable conditions and rules for effecting payments and the use of other applications with the card. Any and all legally binding or other acts that the cardholder carries out with a card will be for your account and risk.
- 7.5 The cardholder can (on your behalf) use a card, if need be in combination with another tool, to do banking or other business with us and/or third parties, such as concluding an agreement with us through an online service or carrying out any other legally binding or other acts, in the event that we so agreed with you and/or the cardholder.
- 7.6 Once the cardholder has used a new or changed application to be used with the card, he/she will in any case (also on your behalf) be deemed to have accepted that new or changed application, as well as the terms and conditions and rules applicable to that application.

8. Paying for public transport using a card

- 8.1 In some cases, the cardholder will be able to use a card, for instance his/her debit card, to pay for public transport. This will be possible only if contactless payments can also be made with that card. The limits applicable to the card also apply to the card's use for public transport, with the exception of the limits generally applicable to contactless payments.
- 8.2 The cardholder can pay for trips with public transport using a card, by checking in and out with a card at gates or poles suitable for that purpose, which can be recognized by the "contactless payment" logo. By checking in and out, the cardholder gives his/her permission for the aggregate payment at the end of the day and/or to reserve an amount on the account.
- 8.3 At the end of the day, the amounts for all the trips the cardholder has made that day in the Netherlands will be added up and debited from the account as a lump sum. Sometimes, the amount is already debited from the account on the day of travel itself. It is also possible that the amount is debited from the account later, e.g. because the debit did not succeed the first time in the absence of enough funds in the account. This payment will be visible in the transaction information in the same way as a payment made at a pay machine.

9. Use of other object as card

- 9.1 Should we offer the option, you may also agree with us that you may use another object to pay at pay machines. Any such object must in any case feature an NFC chip (Near Field Communication) to be able to be used as a card. All rules applicable to the card will also apply in that case.
- 9.2 You will find the objects for which you can make such arrangements with us on the website.
- 9.3 If you have agreed with us that you can use any particular object as a card, you will be able to make contactless payments with it. The limits applicable to such payments will be listed on the website. If you agree with us that such object can be used as a card, we can also make additional arrangements with you, for instance how you give permission for payments and what you must do in case of the object's loss or theft.

10. Making payments and withdrawing cash with card

- 10.1 With a card, possibly in combination with the associated PIN, the cardholder may use the suitable cash dispensers and pay machines that bear the same logo as the logo on the card. When using a cash dispenser or pay machine, the cardholder must strictly follow the applicable instructions for use, including those displayed on the cash dispenser's or pay machine's screen.
- 10.2 The cardholder irrevocably consents to payment by inserting the card into the cash dispenser or pay machine, entering the PIN and pressing the confirmation button.
- 10.3 Is the cardholder located abroad? If abroad, the cardholder may have to sign the slip from the pay machine if the cardholder cannot use the PIN on that pay machine. By signing the slip, the cardholder irrevocably consents to the payment order. The use of a debit card outside Europe must be activated by you or the cardholder via an online service.
- 10.4 On some pay machines, the cardholder will be able to pay with the card without using the PIN, and without the cardholder having to sign the slip from the pay machine. In that case, the cardholder irrevocably consents to the payment order by putting the card into the pay machine and confirming the payment order with the confirmation button if so asked.

11. Withdrawing cash without card

- 11.1 It might be possible in the future to withdraw cash from a cash dispenser without inserting a debit card or credit card in that cash dispenser. In that case, you or the cardholder can make a contactless cash withdrawal. Not all cash dispensers offer the option to make a contactless cash withdrawal.
- 11.2 You or the cardholder authorize a contactless cash withdrawal by holding the debit card, credit card, digital card or another object with which you or the cardholder can make payments close to the cash dispenser, entering the PIN, and pressing the confirmation button. Are you or the cardholder making a cash withdrawal using a digital card on a cell phone or a smartwatch? In that case, you or the cardholder can sometimes also authorize the cash withdrawal in the same manner as when you use that device to make a payment at a pay machine, e.g. by means of a fingerprint, face, iris, pattern or access code of the device. A cash withdrawal can no longer be revoked once you or the cardholder have authorized it.

12. Cash withdrawal limit

- 12.1 A single limit applies for each debit card or credit card to all cash withdrawals combined. The limit includes:
- Cash withdrawals in which the debit card or credit card is inserted in the cash dispenser
 - Contactless cash withdrawals using a debit card or credit card at a cash dispenser
 - Contactless cash withdrawals using a digital card linked to the debit card or credit card referred to before.
- 12.2 You will find the cash withdrawal limits on the website. The provider of the cash dispenser might use different limits.

13. Contactless payment

- 13.1 The cardholder may also carry out contactless payments with the card.
- 13.2 The cardholder can make contactless payments with a card only:
- after making payment with that card and the associated PIN, as described in the Article titled “Making payments and withdrawing cash with card”; or
 - after cash has been withdrawn from a cash dispenser, or
 - after checking the balance in the account at a cash dispenser suitable for that purpose.
- 13.3 We determine whether you and/or the cardholder may agree with us that contactless payments cannot be made with a specific debit card.

14. Contactless payment without PIN at pay machine

- 14.1 The cardholder consents to a contactless payment order without PIN by holding the card against the pay machine for contactless payment. After the cardholder has done so, he/she can no longer revoke the payment order. The excess [eigen risico] described in the Article titled “Liability of account holder” does not apply to such payments.
- 14.2 In the Netherlands and in most other Euro countries, two maximum amounts apply to consecutive contactless payments without PIN. The cardholder can find those amounts on the website.
Should one of the maximum amounts for contactless payments be exceeded, the cardholder must:
- consent to the payment order by entering the PIN and pressing the confirmation button; or
 - consent to the payment order by inserting the card into the pay machine, entering the PIN and pressing the confirmation button.
- 14.3 If the cardholder makes payment in a foreign currency, the amount of that payment will be converted into euros and the maximum amounts stated above will continue to apply.
- 14.4 There will be no consecutive payments without PIN if the cardholder in-between:
- makes payment with the card and the PIN;
 - makes payment with the card and the PIN while inserting the card into the pay machine;
 - withdraws money from a cash dispenser with the card and the PIN;
 - uses the card at a cash dispenser suitable for that purpose to check the balance in the account; or
 - uses any other form of customer authentication permitted by us.
- In the future, we can agree further acts for this purpose with you.

15. Contactless payment with debit card and PIN at pay machine

The cardholder irrevocably consents to a contactless payment with PIN by holding the card against the pay machine for contactless payment, entering the PIN and pressing the confirmation button.

16. Cash Back on Card [Retourpinnen]

- 16.1 The cardholder may use the card for receiving cash back on it [Retourpinnen] at pay machines suitable for that purpose.
Using the “Retourpinnen” cash-back option, the party to whom or which payment was made earlier with a card (hereafter the “payer”) can repay an amount paid earlier with a debit card or a credit card to the cardholder.
If the cardholder uses the debit card in respect of the cash-back option, we will credit the amount to be received to the account linked to that debit card upon receipt by us of the amount and the data needed for the crediting.
If a credit card transaction is reversed, it will be processed as described in the Article titled “Refunding on credit card by third party”.

- 16.2 Outside Europe, the cardholder must, if so requested by the pay machine, also enter the PIN and press the confirmation button on the pay machine.
- 16.3 When using the "Retourpinnen" cash-back option, the cardholder will be provided with a slip containing at least the following data: the date and time of the "Retourpinnen" cash-back transaction, the pay machine number, the amount and a statement that the transaction has been approved.
- 16.4 Following a "Retourpinnen" cash-back transaction, the cardholder must request the slip from the pay machine in addition to the cash register receipt. The cardholder must check whether the slip satisfies the points mentioned above and keep the slip.
- 16.5 Even if the slip received by the cardholder states that the "Retourpinnen" cash-back transaction was approved, we cannot guarantee that the amount in question will be credited to the account. The cardholder can notify us of the non-crediting of his/her account. In that case, we will initiate the "failure to receive 'Retourpinnen' cash-back transaction" procedure. As part of that procedure, the cardholder must submit to us the slip stating that the "Retourpinnen" cash-back transaction was approved. We can then determine the payer's bank and ask it to carry out the "Retourpinnen" cash-back transaction. The payer's bank will then assess and ultimately decide whether the amount of the "Retourpinnen" cash-back transaction will be credited to the account. We play no part therein.

17. Limits

- 17.1 We will set spending limits for the card, and limits for each currency, time unit, application, banking institution, country, the number of transactions to be carried out by the cardholder and/or the amounts the cardholder can dispose of, unless we have agreed otherwise with you. In addition to these limits, there may be additional limits for each cash dispenser or pay machine, for instance depending on the country or the owner of the machine.
- 17.2 We may change the spending limits and/or set new ones.
- 17.3 You and/or the cardholder can take note of the card's standard limits (to be changed) through the website.

18. Reserving

- 18.1 When reserving an amount for a payment, the unused part of the spending limit on the account or credit card will be reduced by the amount of the reservation. This prevents this amount from being used for other payments. Such a reservation cannot be cancelled.
- 18.2 A reserved amount on the account will not yet be incorporated in the balance at the time of its formation. Hence, a reservation will not cause your account to be overdrawn. Once the reservation results in a payment, your balance will decline and your account might become overdrawn.
- 18.3 A reservation will end when:
 - the reservation results in a payment;
 - the reservation is cancelled by the intended payee;
 - a maximum of 30 calendar days have passed.
- 18.4 Reserved amounts can be used for various purposes, for example:
 - when an amount is paid or withdrawn with a card abroad in a currency other than the euro;
 - when paying a deposit while renting a car;
 - when paying by card at an unmanned gas station;
 - when you or the cardholder opt for having an order delivered in parts and agree with the seller to pay by card for each partial delivery.
- 18.5 When an amount has been reserved on the account or credit card and you have also gone bankrupt or have been granted a suspension of payments, a statutory debt relief scheme has been declared applicable to you, your bankruptcy or suspension of payments has been applied for, or a request for a statutory debt relief scheme has been filed in your respect, or your account has been attached, the reservation and its conversion into a payment will not be affected by that bankruptcy, suspension of payments, statutory debt relief scheme or attachment. While the money is yours until the moment when the reservation is converted into a payment, it is subject to the resolutive condition that the reservation is converted timely into a payment. The fulfillment of this resolutive condition has effect under property law. This means that e.g. a trustee in bankruptcy, administrator, party levying an attachment or yourself:
 - cannot cancel a reserved amount, and
 - cannot ask us to prevent or cancel a conversion of a reservation into a payment.

19. Barring use of card; end of use of card

19.1 Every account holder may terminate an individual card as per our rules. We may also choose to do so. We do not have to pay any costs already paid (in advance) for a specific period for that card back to the account holder. When the agreement ends, the cardholder must destroy the card by cutting the chip and the magnet strip into pieces. Please note that we will never ask our customers to return an old card.

19.2 The cardholder may no longer use the card in the following cases.

- We request the cardholder to stop using the card.
- The card is no longer valid.
- The cardholder still has the card in his/her possession or regains possession of the card following any report of the card's loss, theft, misuse or counterfeiting (or any suspicion thereof).
- The account and/or the agreement is/are terminated or ends/end.
- The balance in the account is placed under administration.
- An attachment is levied on us to your detriment or satisfaction is otherwise sought from the account and/or we apply for this.
- You and/or the cardholder dies/die or is/are placed under legal guardianship.
- You have gone bankrupt or have been granted a suspension of payments, a statutory debt relief scheme has been declared applicable to you, your bankruptcy or suspension of payments has been applied for, or a request for a statutory debt relief scheme has been filed in your respect.
- The cardholder loses the power to use the card.
- You or the cardholder fails to fulfill the obligations in our respect.

If the account is maintained by multiple account holders and one of the account holders terminates the individual power to dispose of the account, the cardholder may no longer use the card.

19.3 We may bar the use of a card for, among other things, the following reasons:

- All cases listed in paragraph 19.2.
- We suspect that a card has been lost, stolen, misused or counterfeited.
- The increased risk that you are no longer able to fulfill the payment obligations in our respect.

In case of the barred use of the card, we will inform you and/or the cardholder about such barred use and the reason for it. We will not do so if we have good reason not to do so, such as out of safety considerations or for privacy reasons.

20. Incidents with card or PIN

20.1 If the cardholder knows or suspects that a card has been or may be lost, stolen, misused or counterfeited, or that a third party knows the PIN, if the card was not returned to the cardholder following a payment, or if the cardholder notices that one or more payments have been carried out with the card, but not by the cardholder :

- the cardholder must report this as quickly as possible to our helpdesk as communicated by us, and have the use of the card in question immediately (temporarily) barred;
- if the cardholder still has the card in his/her possession or has regained possession of it following the report, the cardholder may only use the card whose use has been temporarily barred if the cardholder is certain that the card (data) has not changed hands. If there is any doubt as to whether the card (data) has changed hands, the cardholder may no longer use the card whose use has been (possibly temporarily) barred and must immediately destroy the card by cutting the chip and magnet strip into pieces. The cardholder can again use the card only if the temporary bar on its use has been lifted.

We will (temporarily) bar the use of the card as quickly as possible upon taking note of the report.

20.2 The cardholder must observe our rules in the cases set forth below.

- The card's refusal, taking in or invalidation by electronic equipment when using one or more applications, which may happen if, for instance:
 - we have withdrawn authorization for the use of the card;
 - erroneous PINs are used;
 - the card has been damaged;
 - the electronic equipment intended for the use of one or more applications has been damaged and/or modified; and/or
 - the card is not removed from the electronic equipment used on time.
- The card has become unusable (in any other way).

- 20.3 We will ensure that the cardholder can report the incidents listed above in paragraph 20.2 to the helpdesk as communicated to us on a 24/7 basis. More information can be found on the website.
If the cardholder has reported an incident as set forth above in paragraph 20.2, we will immediately upon taking note of such report bar the use of the card and make a new card and/or PIN available to the cardholder as quickly as possible.
- 20.4 You must apply for a new card if a card has been invalidated during the use of one or more applications in electronic equipment intended for that purpose, or if the cardholder has reported the fact that the card has been taken in . In that case, we will make a new card and/or PIN available to the cardholder as quickly as possible.
- 20.5 In the event that the card has been refused, taken in or invalidated by the electronic equipment intended for the use of one or more applications, we will, if possible and at the cardholder's request, state the reason for this, unless this is undesirable in connection with fraud prevention and/or detection, and/or the security and/or protection of the interests of other parties.

21. How to pay online with a new debit card or credit card

- 21.1 When you or the cardholder want to pay online with a debit card, you can only do so with a new debit card. These new debit cards are identifiable by the PAN on the card. You or the cardholder might also have to use Rabo Business Banking or the Rabo Scanner in that case.
- 21.2 When paying online with a debit card or credit card, e.g. at an online store, you or the cardholder can opt for paying with a debit card or credit card on that website.
- 21.3 You will be asked to authorize the payment:
- sometimes by entering the PAN and, for a credit card, also the CVC or CVV code;
 - sometimes by signing the payment order, with the signing code of the Rabo Scanner or via Rabo Business Banking.
- Various factors determine whether and how the payment order must be signed; e.g. the payment amount, whether it is a debit card or credit card, and the country in which the payee is domiciled or registered.

Credit card

The payment order can be signed in the same ways as a payment order for a transfer, e.g. by means of the five-digit code, fingerprint or with the signing code of the Rabo Scanner. In that case, the signing code must be created using the credit card and the Rabo Scanner. When you or the cardholder log in to Rabo Online Banking, you'll see the details of the credit card payment to be signed by you or the cardholder.

Debit card

When you or the cardholder log in to Rabo Online Banking, you'll see the details of the credit card payment to be signed by you or the cardholder. The payment order can be signed in the same ways as a payment order for a transfer, e.g. by means of the five-digit code, fingerprint or with the signing code of the Rabo Scanner. In the future, you will be able to sign the payment order just with the signing code of the Rabo Scanner.

- 21.4 The payment order is final and cannot be revoked.
- 21.5 Online payments with debit card or credit card are subject to debit card and credit card limits. These can be found on the website. This excludes limits applicable to other online payments such payments using iDEAL or transfers.

22. Receiving money on your account via your debit card

In the future, you will be able to receive money on your accounts by means of a debit card. In that case, a payer must be able to pay to a PAN, among others, or you or the cardholder must possess a new debit card, which is identifiable by the PAN on the card.

23. Making payments by leaving the debit card or credit card information with a third party online

- 23.1 You or the cardholder may agree with a third party that the latter can charge amounts to your debit card or credit card. You or the cardholder do so by leaving the debit card or credit card information with that third party online.
- 23.2 There are various ways in which the debit card or credit card information can be left with a third party. Sometimes, you must sign using one of our security resources, such as the five-digit code or a signing code created by means of your debit card or credit card and Rabo Scanner.

24. Linking credit card data to an account at a third party

- 24.1 In some cases, permission can be granted via an online service for a third party to store the debit card or credit card information with an account, enabling for instance faster payment for the next order or amounts to be charged to the debit card or credit card. You or the cardholder will receive a request to provide a signature via your online service when this third party asks us to do so. If a signature is not provided or if you want these data deleted or not stored, you or the cardholder must contact this third party yourself.
- 24.2 If the credit card data have been changed, for instance because you have received a new card, it is possible that you or the cardholder must once more grant permission to the third party for storing the data when requested.
- 24.3 If the third party requests permission to store debit card or credit card information when you or the cardholder must sign a payment order and you or the cardholder do not want to do so, assess whether you can pay in another manner in which you or the cardholder do not have to authorize the storage of card information.

25. Updating new card information at a payee

- 25.1 If debit card or credit card information has been passed on to a payee, e.g. because that payee charges you periodically an amount for a subscription or you or the cardholder receive a new card from us, the payee can request the information of the new debit card or credit card from Mastercard or Visa so that you or the cardholder do not have to do this update yourself.
- 25.2 You or the cardholder might periodically be asked to confirm the new card information at an online service.
- 25.3 If you are unsure that you or the cardholder possess the new card information and you want to make sure that your subscription continues uninterrupted, for instance, ask the payee whether the payee has the new card information.

4. Special provisions regarding credit cards

26. Payment with credit card

The cardholder can pay with a credit card at a pay machine suitable for that purpose. Sometimes, the cardholder can pay with a credit card even when there is no pay machine present. In case of a transaction without a pay machine, the card's data must be registered. This is done by copying the card's data onto a form to be dated and signed by the cardholder, stating the total amount payable. By signing, the cardholder irrevocably consents to the payment order.

27. Online payment with credit card and the CVC code or CVV code

27.1 The cardholder can use a credit card to pay amounts in euros and in other currencies through the Internet. The cardholder can irrevocably consent to the relevant payment order in four ways:

- by entering, on the relevant website of the party whom or which the cardholder wishes to pay, the PAN, its expiry date and the three-digit number on the reverse side of the credit card (the CVC or CVV code); or
- by entering and confirming a personal secret code on the website of the party whom or which the cardholder wishes to pay. The cardholder can create a personal secret code (the S code of the Random Reader or the signing code of the Rabo Scanner) using a tool suitable for that purpose and made available by Rabobank, such as the Random Reader or the Rabo Scanner, the credit card and the PIN associated with the credit card;
- By signing the payment order via an online service. The manner in which you do this is stipulated in the terms governing that online service;
- if the cardholder cannot sign via an online service, the cardholder can enter and confirm a personal secret code on a site specified by Rabobank. The cardholder can create a personal secret code (the S code of the Random Reader or the signing code of the Rabo Scanner) using a tool suitable for that purpose and made available by Rabobank, such as the Random Reader or the Rabo Scanner, the credit card and the PIN associated with the credit card.

27.2 Should any other ways of consenting to the payment order be required or approved, we will notify you and/or the cardholder, for example through the website or an online service, how these work.

27.3 How the cardholder can make payment will be stated on the website of the party whom or which the cardholder is paying. A maximum amount for each payment order and for payment orders over a specific period will apply. Those maximum amounts are stated on the website.

27.4 You can also make a periodic payment, which can be charged monthly, for instance. In that case, the amount can be fixed or variable, as specified on the screen on which the cardholder signs. By signing, the cardholder irrevocably consents to the payment order.

27.5 The payment order can be signed via an online service immediately or later. If the payment order is not signed immediately, the cardholder will receive a notification via the online service asking the cardholder to sign. This notification remains visible for a limited amount of time.

28. Withdrawing cash with credit card

The cardholder can also use his/her credit card to withdraw cash abroad at offices of the bank or other offices that are recognizable by the Mastercard or Visa logo on the credit card only. Those offices may ask for valid means of identification acceptable to the office in question to be produced. The cardholder irrevocably consents to the payment order by signing the form intended for that purpose.

29. Monthly settlement of credit card

29.1 We will periodically provide you and/or the cardholder with a (digital) transaction statement breaking down the total amount of the payments made with the credit card. You must check this transaction statement periodically, in any case within seven days of receipt, and report any inaccuracies to us. At the end of each

month, you must pay us the total amount of the payments made with the credit card, including payments made with a temporary credit card and if applicable the interest charged by us. The total amount will be reduced by the balance, if any, on the credit card owing to retransfers with the credit card stated in the same transaction statement as the payments and/or money credited to the credit card.

- 29.2 In the event that, at the end of the month, the amount in retransfers made with the credit card exceeds the payments effected by the cardholder with a credit card during that month, that balance will automatically be refunded to the account. This can happen at the end of the month, as well as in the course of the month. We will decide when the refund takes place.
- 29.3 The total amount may be paid to us in various ways. We will decide how and may also change the procedure in the interim. For instance, payment can be made by:
- us debiting the account and a credit facility, if any, (also) of you, even if the balance in the account is insufficient;
 - remitting money from the account to a credit card or repaying money on the credit card; or
 - you issuing to us and/or a third party approved by us one or more SEPA direct-debit mandates as soon as we so request, in order to direct debit the amounts due from one or more accounts (also) of you with another financial institution.

30. Remitting money to credit card

- 30.1 We may offer the option of remitting money from the account to the credit card. We will decide which credit cards offer this option. We may also make additional arrangements about this with you. More information is given on our website.
- 30.2 The money on the credit card is covered by the Dutch deposit guarantee scheme [depositogarantiestelsel].
- 30.3 We will not pay interest with respect to the money on the credit card, but we are allowed to charge interest. If we charge interest, we will settle this in the same way as described in the Article titled "Monthly settlement of credit card". We may also settle the interest from another account that is (also) in your name even if the balance in the account is insufficient and this settlement results in an unauthorized debit balance. We have the right to change this. We may also settle the payment of interest directly with the money on the credit card.
- 30.4 If an amount is remitted to the credit card, we will determine the date from which you must pay interest on this. If an amount is debited from the credit card, we will determine the date until which you must pay interest on this. We have the right to change both dates.
- 30.5 We may determine how we calculate the interest. We may also determine the calculation period for the interest.
- 30.6 We have the right to change:
- the settlement date of the interest;
 - the calculation method of the interest;
 - the calculation period of the interest;
 - the number of days in a month or a year, which we use in the calculation of interest;
 - the period after which you have to pay the interest, for instance after a week or a month.
- 30.7 In the event that it is possible to remit money to a credit card, the following will apply:
- you and/or the cardholder will remit an amount to an IBAN to be determined by us, as described on the website. We will subsequently ensure that the money will be remitted to the credit card.
 - subsequently, the cardholder can make payment and withdraw money with the credit card in the ways described in these terms and conditions;
 - in the event that the cardholder makes payment or withdraws money with the credit card, the amount in question will first be debited from the sum on the credit card, after which the money spent will be applied to the spending limit on the credit card;
 - in the event that the cardholder makes a payment for which an amount is reserved, the amount of the reserve will be deducted from the spending limit;
 - the cardholder may spend the amount on the credit card at a pay machine or an online checkout system;
- Please note: the amount on the credit card can be spent all at once at a pay machine, not just the spending limit. Cash may also be withdrawn from cash dispensers or at the counter of a bank. This means that, when you of the cardholder remit an amount to the credit card, you incur more risk if you fail to comply with the security rules as the unused part of the spending limit is higher for the credit card.

30.8 We may in each instance limit the amount that you or the cardholder can remit to the credit card or set limits as to the total amount to be remitted to the credit card. We may also limit the period during which an amount may be on the credit card. At the end of this term, we may remit the money on the credit card to an account that is (also) in your name. We will determine which account.

31. Refunding on credit card by third party

31.1 In some cases, an amount will be refunded through your credit card. In that case, the amount will be stated as a credit amount in your transaction statement.

31.2 If a payer indicates that an amount has been refunded through the credit card but the transaction statement does not show a credit amount, you must contact the payer yourself. We will not be liable for this.

31.3 You may not have to pay us anything at the end of a month owing to a refund, as the amount thereof may exceed the amount of your payments and withdrawals for that month. If that is the case, the positive balance of the refund, less the payments and withdrawals, will automatically be refunded to the account. This can happen at the end of the month, as well as in the course of the month. We will decide when the refund takes place.

31.4 You may also contact us to let us know that you wish to have the balance credited to the contra account. You can do so through an online service or by contacting us directly. The Article titled "Repayment of money on credit card" will apply in this respect.

32. Repayment of money on credit card

32.1 The amount on the credit card can be refunded to the account. This can happen at the end of the month, as well as in the course of the month. We will decide when the refund takes place.

32.2 You or the cardholder may request us to refund all or a part of the money, if any, on the credit card to the account.

As long as the cardholder still has a credit card, repayment of the money (or any part thereof) on the credit card into the account linked to the credit card may be requested.

32.3 The procedure for requesting the repayment of money on the credit card is described on the website.

32.4 No costs will be charged for requests for the repayment of money on the credit card:

- as long as the cardholder still has a credit card, which may also be a credit card other than the credit card that you had when the money was remitted to the credit card;
- if you and/or the cardholder requests the repayment of money on the credit card within less than a year of the cardholder no longer having a credit card of us.

32.5 In the event that you and/or the cardholder no longer has/have a credit card and the repayment of the money on the credit card is requested more than a year later, we may charge costs for this.

32.6 We will have the right to retransfer the money on the credit card to the account, for instance where you and/or the cardholder fails/fail to fulfill (or no longer fulfills/fulfill) the obligations.

33. Retransferring amounts

33.1 In the event that we have charged one or more incorrect amounts to you, for instance in connection with payments effected with the credit card, you must so notify us in writing as quickly as possible, but no later than within 13 months of the transaction being effected. In that written notification, you must also state the reason for the inaccuracy. Upon receipt by us of the written notification within the period set, we will retransfer the amount (or any part thereof) that was incorrectly charged. In the event that a later investigation shows that the amounts in question were correctly charged, we will again charge that amount to you, plus any interest and costs of retransfer and/or the investigation.

33.2 The right to a retransfer will not apply in the event that the payment was processed properly but the cardholder has a dispute with the party to whom or which the cardholder made payment using the credit card.

34. Credit card insurance

We have taken out insurance for our credit-cardholders. In certain cases, this insurance covers loss of, theft of and damage to goods paid for by credit card. Information about this insurance is provided on our website.

5. Further arrangements made with you

35. Obligations of cardholder

35.1 The cardholder must handle the card and the associated PIN with due care, and take any and all reasonable measures to safeguard the safety of the card and the PIN. In doing so, the cardholder must at least observe the rules to be determined in more detail by us.

Reasonable measures will in any case include:

- at all times storing or keeping the card in a place not accessible to another party; and
- memorizing the PIN.

The cardholder will be responsible for the card and the associated PIN (and/or their use) as from the moment of which the cardholder can dispose thereof. We will inform you and the cardholder to the best possible extent about the precautionary measures to be taken. The cardholder must take the measures prescribed by us to prevent any use of the card by an unauthorized party.

The cardholder must also, on a regular basis, consult the information provided by us or on our behalf about measures the cardholder can take to prevent fraud with the card. The cardholder can find this information on the website, among other places.

35.2 The cardholder will be obliged to always store the card safely.

The cardholder has stored the card safely only if he/she:

- keeps the card in his/her wallet or a comparable storage place, and keeps it out of sight of other parties when the card is not used;
- stores the card out of sight of other parties;
- stores the card in a way that other parties cannot reach for it unnoticed; and
- takes good care not to lose the card.

35.3 The cardholder must always use the card safely.

The cardholder will use the card safely only if he/she:

- never gives the card to another party, even if that party wants to help the cardholder, unless the cardholder uses the card at a pay machine and constantly keeps it in sight;
- keeps an eye on the card until the cardholder has stored the card safely;
- always checks whether his/her own card has been returned to him/her upon the card's use;
- meticulously observes the rules displayed on a cash dispenser or a pay machine on checking the safety of that cash dispenser or pay machine;
- immediately contacts us or the helpdesk communicated by us in the event that the card was not returned to him/her following a payment or withdrawal at a cash dispenser;
- does not use the card if the cardholder knows or suspects that the use of the card is or may be unsafe in a specific situation; and
- does not let him-/herself be distracted when using the card.

The cardholder will be obliged to check whether the card is still in his/her possession at least once a day.

35.4 The cardholder must keep the PIN granted to him/her secret in respect of any party, including family members, housemates, fellow account holders and attorneys in fact. The cardholder may not state the PIN on the card.

The cardholder will be obliged to destroy the letter by which he/she receives the PIN immediately upon opening that letter and reading the PIN.

The cardholder must memorize the PIN.

In the event that the cardholder cannot remember the PIN, he/she may make a note of the PIN in a form not recognizable to other parties and must not keep such note on or with the card.

35.5 The cardholder will be obliged to use the PIN safely. The cardholder will use the PIN safely only if he/she:

- takes any and all necessary precautionary measures, so that others cannot see, read or otherwise get to know the PIN when the cardholder is entering the PIN on, for example, a cash dispenser or a pay machine;

- refuses to accept any help from another party when entering the PIN; and
- chooses or changes the PIN him-/herself and the PIN chosen is not easy to guess.

Non-compliance by you and/or the cardholder with the obligations laid down in this Article will render you liable as set out in the Article titled "Liability of you and/or the cardholder". In the event that the cardholder is an attorney in fact, this will also lead to liability as set out in the Article referred to above.

36. Liability of you and/or cardholder

- 36.1 You will be jointly and severally liable for any use of the card (and/or the consequences thereof), even if an obligation to return or destroy the card has arisen.
- 36.2 You will be fully liable in the event of an intentional act or omission, or gross negligence on your part and/or on the part of the cardholder, without prejudice to our obligation to limit damage (or prevent it from arising). There will in any case be an intentional act or omission, or gross negligence on your part and/or on the part of the cardholder in the event that the cardholder failed to keep the PIN secret and/or to safeguard the safety of the card, any non-permitted payments are effected with the card or the card is used wrongfully.
- 36.3 In addition, you will be liable for the consequences of any unauthorized use prior to the cardholder reporting the card's loss, theft, misuse or counterfeiting (or any suspicion thereof), or the knowledge or suspicion that the PIN associated with the card is known to other parties, up to a total amount of one hundred and fifty euros (€150) if the card has been used in combination with the associated PIN. However, without prejudice to the provisions laid down in this Article, you will not be liable for the consequences of any unauthorized use of the card in relation to parking meters, parking garages and/or toll roads. In this connection, payments as referred to in paragraph 10.4 of the Article titled "Making payments and withdrawing cash with card" or paragraph 14.1 of the Article titled "Contactless payment without PIN at pay machine" must be involved, and you must have fully observed the rules issued by us or on our behalf, the agreement and the applicable conditions.
- 36.4 The limitation of the liability as referred to above in paragraph 36.3 will lapse in the event that:
- the cardholder failed to report an incident as referred to promptly upon having had to detect it to the helpdesk communicated by us; and/or
 - the unauthorized payment or payments could take place because the cardholder failed to fulfill his/her obligation to observe confidentiality with respect to the PIN granted to him/her and/or to store the card safely.
- 36.5 The amount referred to above in paragraph 36.3 for which you are liable will be increased by the amount of the unauthorized payment or payments taking place as of seven days of us making available the information listing an unauthorized payment for the first time up to the moment of reporting the incident.
- 36.6 Together with you, the cardholder will be jointly and severally liable in full for any use of the card (and/or the consequences thereof), even if the obligation to destroy the card has arisen.

37. Limitation and exclusion of our liability

- 37.1 We will not be liable for:
- the consequences of not or no longer being able to use the card and/or an application, due to any cause whatsoever;
 - the refusal, for example by a third party or an automated system forming part of the payment process, to accept the card for any reason whatsoever;
 - non-current, incorrect or incomplete information (regarding the balance), transaction statements and/or calculations; and/or
 - the unauthorized use of a PIN and/or a card up until the moment at which we have received notification thereof as described in the Article titled "Incidents with card or PIN".
- 37.3 Are we liable to you? Should we be liable, our liability will be limited to the obligation to pay you any loss of interest only by way of damages, up to a maximum of two hundred and twenty-five euros (€225) for each breach and for each series of related breaches. We will not be liable for any other direct or indirect damage.

38. Information

- 38.1 We provide you with information and allow you to take note of that information. It will be up to you to choose, from the ways offered by us, how you wish to receive the information, which includes the electronic provision of the information. The information will, for example, state the amounts of the payments effected with the card.

- 38.2 We will need to make the information available to one account holder only. That account holder will be obliged to also give this information to the other account holders and/or cardholders.
- 38.3 You must immediately check the information provided to you by us. In the event that we allow you to take note of information (for instance through an online service), you must check the information at least once every seven days.
- 38.4 You must immediately notify us of any inaccuracies in the information provided by us. The content of that information is considered to have been approved by you in the event that you fail to notify us as soon as possible, within thirteen months of the information being able to be deemed to have reached you, at the latest. In the event that the information contains calculation errors, we will be authorized and obliged to also correct such calculation errors after the said thirteen-month period has passed.
- 38.5 In the event and to the extent that the applicable privacy laws, rules and regulations allow such, we will be entitled:
- to place data that we dispose of regarding you and/or the cardholder, including the agreement, the account and the rights and security (also) attaching thereto, at the disposal of business units of Rabobank Group within the framework of efficient operations, including the acceptance policies at group level and the relationship management activities in respect of the account holder, as well as making data available for the performance of the agreement between you and us, the provision of advice to you, and activities geared to guaranteeing the financial sector's safety and integrity;
 - to process any personal or other data regarding you and/or the cardholder and payment order data or cash withdrawals (or have such processed) abroad.

In doing so, personal data may also be shared with countries outside the European Union. This may lead to the transfer of such data to third parties in countries that do not provide the same level of protection for personal data as is common in the European Union. The authorities of those countries, be they in or outside the European Union, can investigate such data, both during and after their processing. This may, for instance, be done by a supervisory authority or another competent body that must give us information on the basis of an agreement or the law, or a supervisory authority that requests your personal data within the framework of an investigation, during or after their processing. Any parties engaged by us may also ask us for additional data regarding you, for instance to be able to comply with their laws. We may then ask you for your permission to provide your data. In the event that we do not give the information referred to above, for instance because you do not want this or because we are not allowed to give such information, this may have consequences for the services provided to you. For example, payments cannot be effected (temporarily) or we must terminate the agreement with you. In carrying out the payment order, we include the payer's or payee's name, address and city. Prior to a payment order, we do not provide any address and/or city relating to an account holder with an IBAN with us; and/or

- to provide any and all personal or other data that we dispose of regarding you and/or the cardholder to our legal successor or successors.

39. Notifications

We will send you and/or the cardholder notifications, for example via SMS text messages or push notifications. You can configure notifications yourself through an online service so that you receive them in specific cases.

40. Evidence

Any and all data kept by us, for instance regarding the performance or the use of the agreement, an account, a card, an online service or a PIN or other security code, will constitute full evidence in your respect and in respect of the cardholder. This also applies to the data of the parties engaged by us. You and/or the cardholder may at all times submit evidence to the contrary.

41. Currency

- 41.1 Any payments in another currency will be converted into euros in a way to be determined by us and on the basis of an exchange rate and exchange rate date to be determined by us. In doing so, we may apply an exchange rate margin. We may also at all times change the value date, the exchange rate date, the exchange rate, the conversion method and the exchange rate margin.
- 41.2 If you pay with a card at a pay machine in a currency other than the euro or withdraw such other currency at a cash dispenser, you will not receive a notification with exchange rate information from us as referred to in Article 3a of Regulation (EU) 2019/518. However, this information is included in the transaction information.

6. Final provisions

42. Costs

- 42.1 We will be authorized to (periodically) charge costs to you for making a card available and/or for the use of a card or for the provision of paper transaction statements. In addition, we will be authorized to charge costs for legally binding or other acts that are and/or have been carried out by the cardholder using a card. We will so notify you, for example through the website or an online service. The costs will be charged to you in euros and we may debit such costs from the account.
- 42.2 We will at all times be authorized to change such costs, the payment date, the calculation period and the calculation method. We will so notify you, for example through the website or an online service.

43. What happens in the event of a merger, demerger, or assignment of contract

- 43.1 We may become subject to a merger (fusie) or demerger (splitsing). If that is the case, our legal successors may jointly and severally:
- exercise all rights and powers in your respect and/or in respect of the cardholder; and
 - perform all our obligations in your respect and/or in respect of the cardholder.
- 43.2 We may transfer the legal relationship(s) between you and us including all rights and ancillary rights (rechten en evenrechten) relating thereto to another party. We may do so partly or fully. This is called a contract takeover. You and/or the cardholder may not transfer the legal relation with us.
- 43.3 Under a contract takeover, our legal successors may, independently and each for the whole, in respect of those legal relation or relations:
- exercise all rights and powers in your respect and/or in respect of the cardholder; and
 - perform all our obligations in your respect and/or in respect of the cardholder.
- 43.4 By signing the agreement, you and the cardholder hereby already give us permission for a contract takeover.

44. Amending the general terms and conditions and/or the agreement

- 44.1 We may amend the terms and conditions. We will so notify you and/or the cardholder at least 30 days in advance. We may do so in writing and/or through a message in an online service.
- 44.2 If a provision laid down in the terms and conditions is not (or no longer) valid, we can replace it by another provision that is valid. The invalidity of a provision will not affect the other provisions in the terms and conditions.
- 44.3 We may agree with you that we amend parts of the agreement. Such amendments will not result in a new agreement.

45. Dutch Credit Registration Office ("BKR")

In the event that you are a natural person, we may have to report your obligations in our respect to the Dutch Credit Registration Office [Bureau Krediet Registratie, "BKR"] in Tiel, the Netherlands. We may at all times notify BKR of your non-payment or late payment in our respect.

46. Declaring laws, rules and regulations non-applicable

The Articles from EU Directive 2015/2366 implemented by the Dutch Market Conduct Supervision (Financial Institutions) Decree (BGfo) in Book 7 of the Dutch Civil Code [Burgerlijk Wetboek] about which that Directive provides, in Articles 38 and 61, that they can be agreed to be inapplicable if you are not a consumer will not be applicable to these terms and conditions.

47. Residence

If your address is not known to us, you will be deemed to have chosen our head office as your residence and/or domicile. All notifications intended for you may be effected there, and all notices and documents intended for you will be delivered and/or served there.
